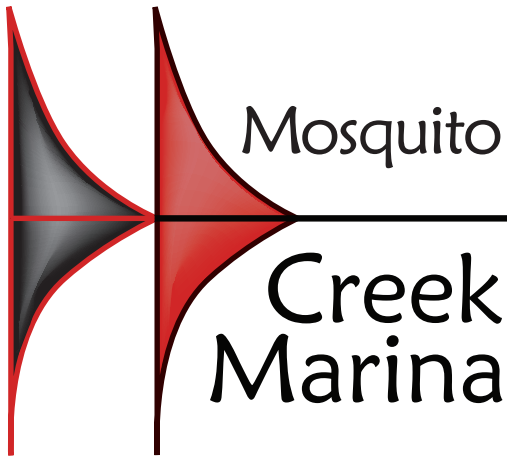

(North Vancouver, 13 July 2010) On September 9-12, 2010 the Mosquito Creek Marina will host the **Squamish Nation Days and 4th Annual Boat Show** –the largest annual boat show held on Vancouver’s North Shore. The event is expected to draw 2,000 people from across the Pacific Northwest during the Thursday to Sunday run.

Donny Mekilok, General Manager of the Mosquito Creek Marina, said:

“For the 4th Annual Boat Show, we have more than doubled our capacity for both vendors and attendees. Yacht Brokers will have dock space for an additional one hundred sail and power boats this year, and transient moorage for yachts up to 100 feet can be reserved immediately. We have special Boat Show moorage rates and Fuel Dock pricing in place for people who plan to attend the show by boat.”

“Whether someone is considering a new sail or power boat, or an upgrade to their current vessel, this event will offer more opportunities than ever for people to get out on the water with friends and family. This show will be very much a hands on experience —one that gives consumers a chance to make real world comparisons, talk to experts in the industry, and have fun in a relaxed, family-friendly setting.”

Festivities for the Squamish Nation Days include daily opening ceremonies with Squamish Nation drummers and dancers, scheduled canoe races, and a food court offering a variety of local cuisines.

This past year marked the start of a new float home development at Mosquito Creek: Spirit Trail Ocean Homes, the first of its kind in Canada. An Ocean Home display model, information packets, and sales representatives will be available over the entire course of the show to answer questions.

About the Squamish Nation Marine Group

The Squamish Nation owns and operates the Mosquito Creek & Lynnwood Marinas in North Vancouver. In addition to the two full service marinas, they custom manufacture all-aluminium Boat Sheds and the new Spirit Trail Ocean Homes, a signature line of luxury floating homes, designed and built in British Columbia.

The Commercial Division offers timber and concrete dock construction, commercial welding, aluminium ramp and gangway fabrication, and marina construction and operation consulting services. The addition of an HDPE Welding Division at The Lynnwood facility has provided an opportunity to supply an environmentally friendly, high-quality alternative to traditional Styrofoam flotation to the marine industry, with first year's sales well above projections.

Mosquito Creek Marina

Located in North Vancouver, British Columbia, "The Creek" is strategically tucked between Grouse Mountain and Vancouver, 10 minutes from Lonsdale Quay and the SeaBus Terminal with ferries every 15 minutes to downtown. From the expanded Marine Fuel Bar –open 7 day/week– the marina is a short cruise from the Lions Gate Bridge and the Georgia Straight.

Mosquito Creek Marina has been owned and operated by the Squamish Nation since 1963.

Spirit Trail Ocean Homes

Designed and constructed on Vancouver's North Shore, Spirit Trail Ocean Homes are built with all the features that reflect the West Coast lifestyle: these new floating homes feature all-concrete floats, high performance EnergyStar® certified appliances, and a choice of four unique floor plans on three sizes of float.

One, two, and three bedroom models are available in sizes ranging from 885 to 1,580 square feet. Prices start at \$265K for a one-bedroom float home, two-bedroom models from \$345K, and larger models from \$375 – \$475K depending on the floor plan.

Up to twenty homes will be constructed in the first phase. As of July 1, only eight Ocean Homes are still available for contract. Expansion is currently underway at Mosquito Creek Marina for new float home moorage alongside the recently completed Spirit Trail.
